



Amateur Radio Test at the Bay Area Maker Faire

Be one of the first people to say you earned your Amateur Radio License at the Maker Faire!

The Amateur Radio Technician License gives you access to frequencies used for:

- *Controlling robots and drones*
- *High-res robot and drone POV video systems*
- *Tracking weather balloons*
- *Deploying packet and high-speed data mesh networks*
- *Communicating with and via satellites*
- *Bouncing signals off the Moon, meteors, and even airplanes!*

Morse Code is not required. The exam is 35 questions, multiple choice. There are plenty of online resources and apps useful for studying, including free online practice tests. There are also very good books available. You can pass with as little as 1-2 full days of study.

There will be tests on both Saturday May 16th and Sunday May 17th before the Maker Faire opens. Appointment is required. Email test@mfhamtest.com or visit the website.
